Michael Farrell is a nationally respected documentary filmmaker, photographer, artist, writer, and educator.

He began making photographs and assembled objects in the late 1960s during his college years at Indiana University. During the Seventies and Eighties, Michael created a large body of very personal work in photography, drawing, collage, and assembled objects. Since then his work has been seen in exhibitions at and is included in the collections of the Museum of Nebraska Art, the Joslyn Art Museum, the Great Plains Museum, the Wyoming State Museum, and the Sheldon Art Museum.

Along with Michael Forsberg, Farrell is the co-creator of the Platte Basin Time-lapse Project.
