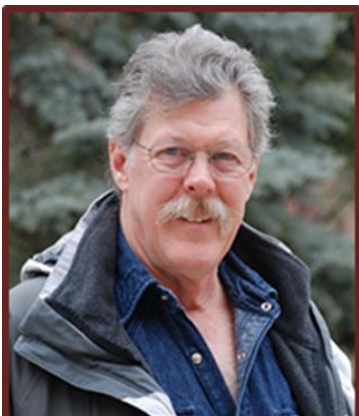


2 Photography Prints, signed by the photographer, of Spring Creek Prairie Audubon Center at different seasons
