Calling all Architects, Artists, and Designers! The **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** would like you to submit a design for our juried selection portion of the project to help us spread the word about architecture and design, raise funds for the Lincoln Community Learning Centers, and make Lincoln a more beautiful and bird-friendly city. Artists whose pieces are chosen will receive a \$250 stipend for materials/fabrication as well as receive a commission of 1/3 of the sale price from auction proceeds at the fundraising event on March 24, 2023, at the Nebraska History Museum.

By signing this Application & Agreement, I agree to all the terms and conditions of **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** and all such terms hereby incorporated into this Application. I certify that all statements made in this Application are true to the best of my knowledge. I acknowledge **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** is not liable for damage or loss of materials submitted.

1. References to **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** refer to a public art project celebrating the architecture and design of bird habitats. References to the **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** concept, or similar references, shall mean the design used by the Artists for their design(s).
2. Artist does hereby assign to **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** permission to use the Artist's design(s) in connection with the project itself, project promotions, project merchandising, photos, copies (regardless of scale) or in any other form as long as said use is part of the overall project. It is understood that for such purposes, the project shall include the current project, as well as future **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** projects.
3. Artist acknowledges the **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** concept, as an underlying form, as well as being part of an organized public art project, provides substantial value to the Artist's completed work.
4. Artist acknowledges that the work of **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** is of value to the Artist in the promotion of the Artist's work.
5. Completed design proposals and all materials noted in the Artist Application & Agreement must be received by 4:00 p.m., January 27, 2023.
6. Following notification of selection in January of 2023, the Artist will be mailed a \$250 per birdhouse stipend to assist in paying for the materials necessary in the development of each full-scale piece.
7. Upon the sale of the artwork at the auction on March 24, 2023, the Artist's share of the auction price will be 1/3 of the final amount collected after the sale. This amount will be paid to the Artist within 30 days of the auction.
8. Artist agrees to execute their artwork as represented in the Committee-approved project guidelines. Artist agrees that if any alterations or changes are contemplated or occur during creative execution from the originally submitted proposal(s), Artist will contact and consult with Name, who will seek counsel from the Committee if the deviations are acceptable. **Any significant changes must be approved by the Committee. If changes are made without approval, the Artist will refund their \$250 payment to Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project.**
9. Selected Artists will deliver their final sculpture to Lincoln (to a yet to be determined location), on or before March 5, 2023.

10. Artist agrees that once the birdhouse is in their possession that **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** shall have no liability for loss or damage to the artwork(s). Risk of loss shall be borne by the Artist who may make arrangements for insurance.

11. Artist agrees to repair artworks(s) at the request of the **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** should the artworks(s) incur any vandalism or other damage. The Artist will establish a reasonable time frame for the repair(s) to be completed. In addition, the Artist will be compensated for the actual cost of materials and their time at a reasonable rate or will designate another artist who they feel is capable to repair the damage.

12. Artist warrants that the design(s) submitted is an original work of authorship that does not infringe upon the copyrights or any intellectual property rights of others.

13. Artist agrees to indemnify and hold harmless **Big B.A.D. Birdhouse Project** for any claim, cost, or liability resulting from breach of their Application and Agreement by the Artist.
